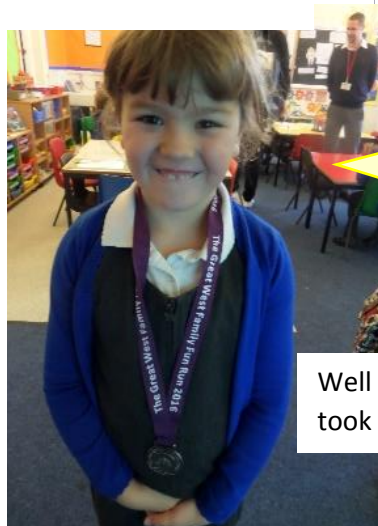

Well done to Charlie (1G) for a fantastic effort with his home learning. Charlie created an Autumn diorama and shared it with class.

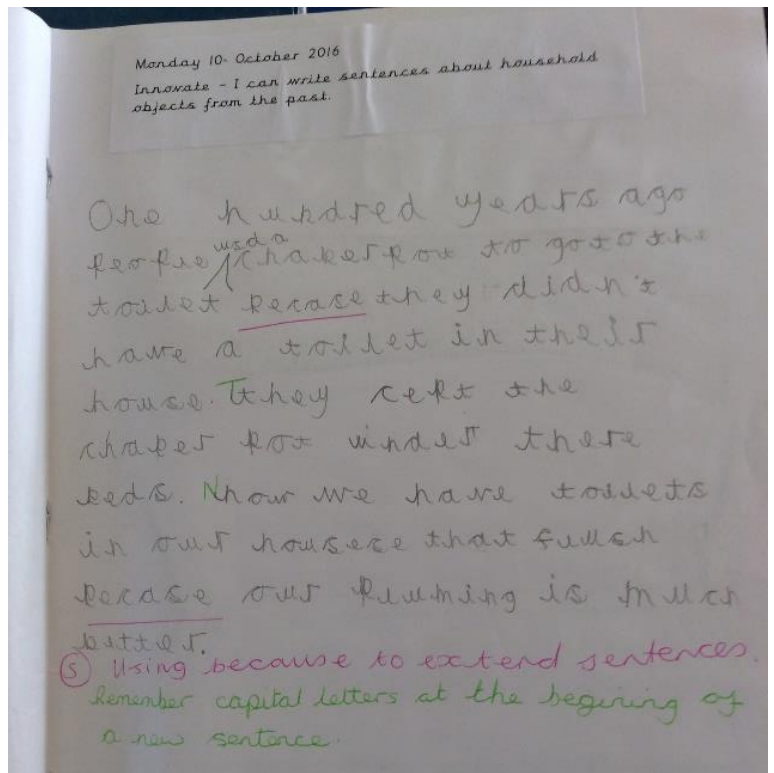


Well done to Eve in 2RE who took part in the Great West Run.

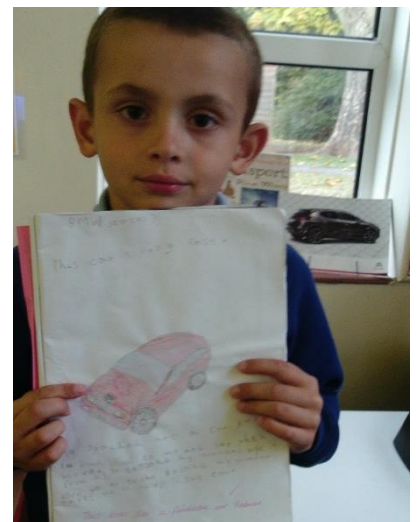


Look at Robbie's (1G) writing. He has thought carefully about his sentences, punctuation and presentation.

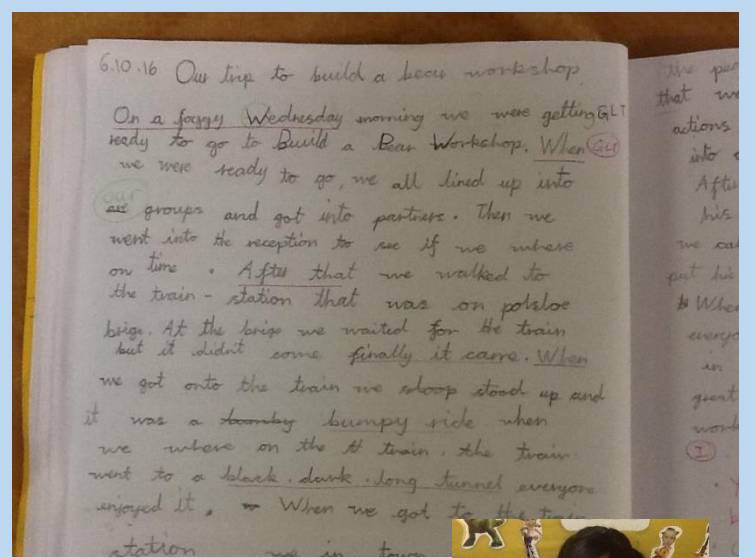

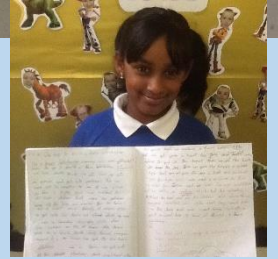
