Dear Parents/Carers of Whipton Barton Federation Year 3 pupils,




This term, Year 3 will be learning about '**The Shang Dynasty**' in their **History** lessons. This unit will teach children about the first historic dynasty of China. They will learn about the fertile land that allowed the Dynasty to grow and thrive



In **Maths**, we will continue learning about multiplication and division by counting in fours, sixes and eights. We will also introduce the children to the concept of remainders.

In **RE**, we will be answering the big question 'What is the trinity and how is it important to Christians?' We will be discussing and sharing our thoughts and understanding respectfully through gospels and symbolism.

In **Computing**, we will be learning about events and actions in programmes.
