Dear Parents/Carers of Whipton Barton Federation **Year 4** pupils,

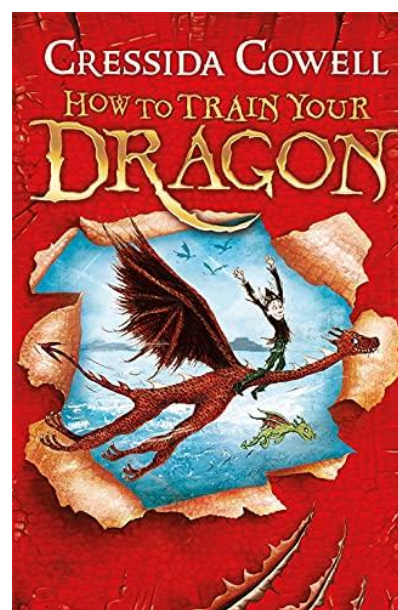
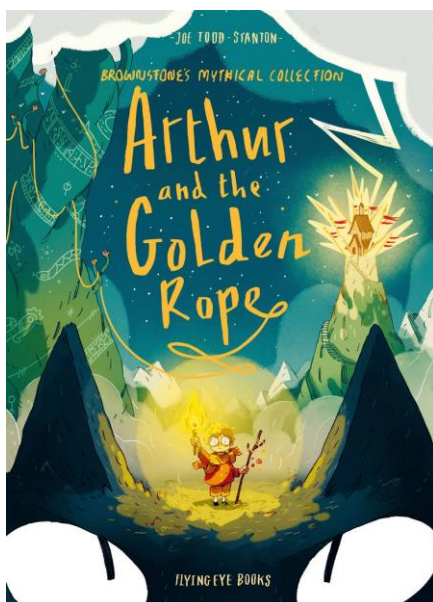
This term, Year 4 will be learning about Vikings in **History**. In this unit, we will discover more about why the Vikings came to Britain and the impact they had on society.

In **Science**, the children will be thinking about electricity in our **Power it up** unit they will be able to use research skills to find out how the electrical appliances work and how electrical circuits are made and apply these skills to make their own

In **English**, the children's adventure narrative writing will be based on the book, Arthur and the Golden Rope by Joe Todd Stanton In whole class **Guided Reading** sessions, they will be studying, How to Train Your Dragon by Cressida Cowell.



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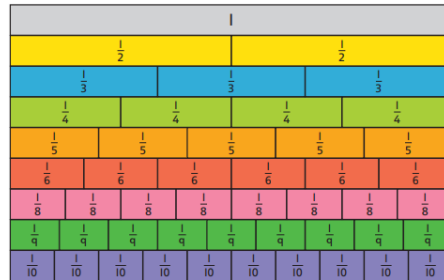
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In **Maths**, the children will be learning more about Fractions, developing their existing knowledge to incorporate adding and subtracting fractions with the same

denominator. The next unit we will explore during this half term is Decimals, the children will explore the relationship between fractions and decimals and consider what happens when a number is divided by 10 or 100.



In **RE**, the children will explore the question, How and why do people mark the significant events of life?. While in **SMSC** (Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural education), the children will learn about Being My Best, where they will discuss their own achievements and how to make informed decisions.



In **Computing**, the children will discover more about HTML codes and how to edit them. In **Art**, they will use a range of materials and techniques to create a Viking scene including sentinels to guard us. In **PE**, they will be learning how to run at speed in Athletics and fundamental coordination skills using coordination and counterbalance. PE will usually be on a Wednesday

and Friday.

In **French**, the children will be introduced to the vocabulary used to describe items usually found in a classroom.
