Objective: to get students engaged and creative

Outcome: a magical map and creative description

Include colours, labels and any useful instructions.
2. Once your map is complete and full of juicy details, write a descriptive paragraph explaining what it feels like to land in this magical place. How did you get here? What can you see? What can you smell? What do you hear?
