4 – 7 year olds: Only have to do pictures

8 – 12 year olds: Add some labels to your poster telling us what you think is a good idea!

The winning pupil(s) will receive an FSC identification guide on **garden birds**. There will be one prize for each of the two age categories (4 -7 years and 8 -12 years).

To participate all you have to do is take a **picture of your work**, with the student's first **name, age and school** and send it to Emily from the education team on ebacon@devonwildlifetrust.org by the deadline of **Sunday 5th July** - we will be in touch with the winner afterwards.
